
### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The admission requirement for Horticulture & Business Management is a secondary school diploma which is equivalent to a Dutch havo/vwo diploma with the final-year subject mathematics and chemistry. Practical (work-) experience is beneficial but not obligatory. The level of your diploma will be assessed after you have uploaded your diploma in Studielink. To find out how your secondary school diploma is valued in the Netherlands, check the Country Module for your country of origin on www.nuffic.nl/en.

### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

Students who have completed their previous education in English are exempt from this requirement. All other students need to provide proof that they are proficient in the English language. HAS advises the IELTS language test (www.ielts.org). Overall band score (academic programma) has to be above 6.0. 
